We seek to walk with our sisters and brothers in Belle-Rivière by providing monetary and emotional support for their needs while respecting the customs and traditions of both communities.

The above Mission Statement has guided the work of the STA Haiti Committee for nearly 30 years. The scope of the current program would have been a lofty dream when this statement was developed in 1990. St. Thomas Aquinas parishioners have been quite generous in supporting the spiritual, educational, health, and nutritional initiatives which are at the core of the programs listed in the financial statement.
