3). Treasurer's Report

The beginning balance in the SVdP account on March 1 was \$10,221.68

\$1,928.65 was received from STA collections

\$2,650.00 was used for the purchase of grocery gift cards for Easter holiday bags

\$1,500.00 was distributed for electric payments

\$500.00 was distributed for gas payments

\$1.95 was used for debit card fee

Total expenses for February was \$4,651.95.

The ending balance in the SVdP account as of April 1 was \$7,498.38

Members present agreed to additional payments of \$500.00 to the Cathedral Soup Kitchen and \$500.00 to our twinning parish in the Dominican Republic. Peggy will investigate the possibility of providing financial assistance for a program that supplies toys and other items to the children of incarcerated women in a local prison

There are currently 2 outstanding requests for assistance. A total of 6 clients received financial assisted in March

Matt reported that during the first 3 months of this year, Boulevard Place Pantry has served an average of 1,227 households per month, representing 3,872 individuals. Bulletin announcements will be each month made requesting donations of specific items needed at the pantry
